2:87, 2:136, 2:253, 3:45, 3:46, 3:48, 3:52, 3:84, 4:163, 5:46, 5:78, 5:112, 19:21, 19:22, 19:27, 19:33, 19:34, 21:91, 23:50, 43:57, 43:61, 43:63, 57:27, 61:14 etc.

Jesus has been distinguished from all other prophets to the extent that even Satan could not harm him. Fact Check Hadith - Sahih Bukhari Vol 4, Book 54 – Satan poked with his finger the side of every human at birth, except Jesus, son of Mary; when he went to poke HIM, he poked the curtain.
