Prologue:

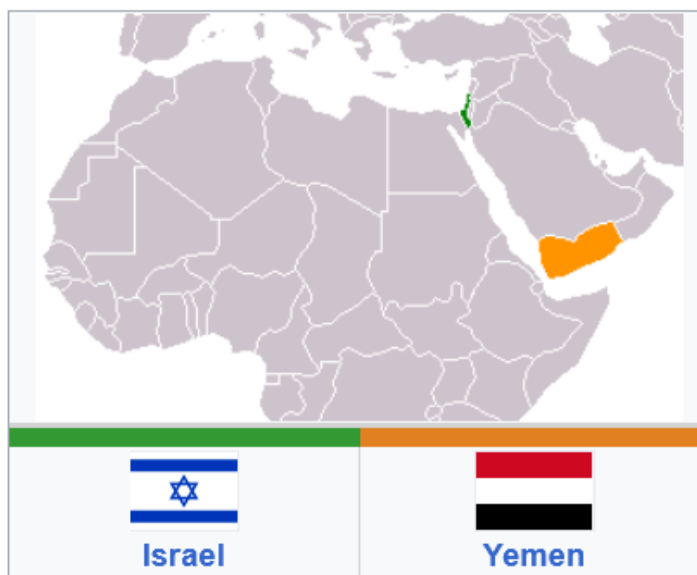

“Secondly, there’s no doubt that the Houthis also wanted to put pressure on Saudi Arabia seeing as how their projectiles had to have travelled through its airspace en route to the self-professed Jewish State. This risks ruining their [on-going peace talks](#), but the group seemingly calculated that showing solidarity with their allies takes precedence over all else, including the chance that this rekindles their mostly frozen conflict with the Kingdom, whether deliberately or by miscalculation.”

Agree or disagree, Yemen took a giant step to ally with the Palestinians. What a display of courage by the Houthis in Yemen to test the sincerity of all the Muslim countries and expose their usual postures of sitting on the fence of inaction.

"The government reminds me of a poker player on tilt, betting more and more crazily in hope of magic or luck to bail him out. It always ends badly."
