
For The Record

Under Vision 2020 from 1991 to 2020, there were Three, 10 year development policies, namely National Development Policy 1991-2000 with OPP2, National Vision Policy 2001-2010 with OPP3 and New Economic Model 2011-2020 with National Transformation Programme. Malaysia failed to achieve the noble objectives of Vision 2020, after the retirement of Tun Mahathir in 2003.

He is sometimes referred to as the Father of Malaysian Economic Development for playing a pivotal role in establishing and implementing key foundations and policies in Malaysian economy. A descendant of Malay royalty, he is a great-uncle of the current Sultan of Kelantan, Sultan Muhammad V.

"He was the Minister of Finance (1976–1984), Minister of International Trade and Industry (1984–1987), former chairman of Asian Development Bank, former chairman of Islamic Development Bank, founding Chairman and Chief Executive of Malaysian oil company, PETRONAS, and chairman of the 33rd Board of Governors of the World Bank and IMF. His popularity has earned him nicknames such as "The People's Prince" and "Ku Kita" (Our Tengku). He is affectionately known as **Ku Li**, derived from the last syllables of Tengku Razaleigh; a common custom in the Kelantan dialect."

Where & How To Start On A Clean Sheet – To Heal Malaysia

- The political and economic environment has changed.
- The old tools and policies are not applicable. In fact, counter-productive.

• The dangerous subversion of our Federal Constitution, the Supreme Law of the Federation.

The arrogant politicians and intellectual masturbators will scream that the above five initiatives are so simple and BS. Yet, none can say that they have "Walked the Talk" on the five simple concepts, the foundation stones for a New Malaysia.

The First Step - The Supreme Law (the Federal Constitution)

What have the desperate scrambles to collect and present Statutory Declarations to the Yang Di-Pertuan Agong taught any of you, citizens of Malaysia, in 2020 and thereafter?

The Oxford Dictionary defines and explains that the word "Sovereign" is a noun and refers to a supreme ruler, especially a monarch. And "Sovereign Immunity" or "Crown Immunity" is a legal doctrine whereby a sovereign or state <u>cannot</u> commit a legal wrong and is <u>immune</u> from civil suit or criminal prosecution, strictly speaking in modern texts <u>in its own courts</u>. State immunity is a similar, but a stronger doctrine, that <u>applies to foreign courts</u>.

Article 43 (2)(a) provides that:

"... the Yang Di-Pertuan Agong shall first appoint as Perdana Menteri (Prime Minister) to preside over the Cabinet a member of the House of Representative who in his judgment is likely to command the confidence of the majority of the members of the House" (further discussions, see End Notes)

The choice of appointing the Prime Minister is entirely up to him and is based on his "<u>subjective</u>" (HIS) judgment! The Yang Di-Pertuan Agong is that powerful!

Have we not heard and seen repeatedly, how political leaders and followers of a certain political party claim that they are in the forefront to "defend" the King, country and Islam. And yet, by an amendment to the Constitution, supported by that party, the Absolute Immunity of the Sovereign has been repealed and curtailed. **See Article 32**

Though it may be politically expedient to do so at the material time, but under our laws, the amendment is repugnant to the doctrine of Sovereign Immunity. It contravenes the Federal Constitution and is void. See Article 4 of the Constitution. The circumstances giving rise to the Amendment to the Constitution, no longer exist. We are now in 2024 and counting!

What is not appreciated at all is that the Rulers, past, present and future, by that Amendment, has been and will be "collectively punished and censored" by that Amendment. This by way of an analogy, is how the Zionist Israelis are "collectively punishing" the people of Gaza when they cannot defeat Hamas in a war going on for over 70 years.

I therefore suggest and advised that as the first step to resolve the dilemmas faced by the country, UMNO should APOLOGISE TO ALL THE RULERS and have the repugnant Amendment **repealed** so that the Dignity and Respect to the Institution of the Rulers be restored to its original status as the Founders of our country have agreed to the advice and recommendation of the Reid Commission - an independent commission responsible for drafting the Constitution of the Federation of Malaya prior to Malayan independence from the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland on 31 August 1957.

"The legislative authority of the Federation <u>SHALL</u> be <u>VESTED</u> in a Parliament which <u>SHALL CONSIST</u> of the Yang Di-Pertuan Agong, and two Majlis (Houses of Parliament to be known as the Dewan Negara (Senate) and the Dewan Rakyat (House of representatives).

Our King is the <u>FIRST ESSENTIAL PART</u> and <u>ONE OF THE THREE PILLARS</u> of Parliament. The King is not there just for the Opening of Parliament.

The irony of it all is that the said Amendment to the Constitution was enacted by politicians in parliament who have to take an oath of loyalty to the Yang Di-Pertuan Agong! I would also suggest that Yang Mulia, Tengku Razaliegh Hamzah assist the Royal Institution as embodied in the Conference of Rulers in Article 38, which has the all requisite powers to protect the Institution of Rulers/

Do I need to say anymore to the hypocrites in Parliament?

Hence, the First Step is to uphold the sanctity of the Federal Constitution – the Supreme law. When we cannot uphold the sanctity of the Supreme Law, any discussion on addressing the remaining issues relating to the dilemmas facing Malaysia is an exercise in futility!
