The first half of theology is theo-, which means god in Greek. The suffix -logy means "the study of," so theology literally means "**the study of god**," but we usually expand it to mean the study of religion more broadly.

The first great theologian, however, was **Socrates' student Plato**, who appears also to have been the first to use the term theology. For Plato, theology was the study of eternal realities, the realm of what he called forms, or ideas.

What is the origin of theology?

Although most people tend to think of theology in the context of modern religious traditions, like Judaism or Christianity, the concept actually dates back to ancient Greece. Philosophers like Plato and Aristotle used it in to reference the study of the Olympian gods and the writings of authors like Homer and Hesiod.3 Jan 2018

It is taught as an academic discipline, typically in universities and seminaries.

Muslims regard Jesus (peace be upon him) as one of the great prophets who brought divine guidance to humanity before Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him and his family).

His name is mentioned in the Holy Qur'an twenty-five times, often in the form 'Isa ibn Maryam, meaning "Jesus, son of Mary." In the Qur'an, he is referred to by the unique title of "Messiah" (*al-masih* in Arabic), meaning "anointed one." He is regarded as one of many

prophets from the hereditary lineage of Prophet Ibrahim, or Abraham (peace be upon him). Many Muslim traditions view him as an ideal exemplar of spirituality.

The Amman Message recognized eight legitimate schools of Islamic law and prohibited declarations of apostasy against them.

- the Hanbalī school, founded by Ahmad ibn Hanbal (8th century CE);

Islam in Malaysia is represented by the **Shafi'i version of Sunni theology** and the practice of any other form of the religion (such as Shia Islam) is heavily restricted by the government.
