'That's what's boiling the oceans, creating these atmospheric rivers, and the rain bombs, and sucking the moisture out of the land, and creating the droughts, and melting the ice and raising the sea level, and causing these waves of climate refugees.'"

In a 2007 speech delivered in Norway after receiving a Nobel Peace Prize for his work informing the public about the dangers posed by climate change, Gore noted research that said the Earth's average temperature would increase by "many degrees" if the amount of carbon in the atmosphere doubled.

Scientists, though, have projected the world's temperature to increase by at most 2.9 degrees Celsius above the pre-industrial period by 2100 when the amount of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere is expected to double.

Another lie by Al Gore.

Steve Milloy, a senior legal fellow at the Energy & Environment Legal Institute and publisher of JunkScience.com, told Fox News Digital in an interview,

Vietnam and Agent Orange

Operation Ranch Hand

During the Vietnam War, the U.S military engaged in an aggressive program of chemical warfare codenamed <u>Operation Ranch Hand</u>. From 1961 to 1971, the U.S. military sprayed a range of herbicides <u>across</u> Vietnam to destroy the forest cover and food crops used by North Vietnamese and Resistance (Viet Cong) troops. U.S. aircraft were deployed to douse roads, rivers, canals, rice paddies and farmland with powerful mixtures of herbicides. During this process, crops and water sources used by the non-combatant native population of South Vietnam were also hit.

In all, American forces used more than 20 million gallons of herbicides in Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia during the years of Operation Ranch Hand. Herbicides were also sprayed from trucks and hand-sprayers around U.S. military bases.

The first batch of herbicides was unloaded at Tan Son Nhut Air Base in South Vietnam, on **January 9, 1962**. U.S. Air Force records show at least **6,542** spraying missions took place over the course of Operation Ranch Hand.

Agent Orange has also caused enormous environmental damage in Vietnam. Over 3,100,000 ha (7,700,000 acres) or 31,000 km² (12,000 sq mi) of forest were defoliated. Defoliants eroded tree cover and seedling forest stock, making

<u>reforestation</u> difficult in numerous areas. Animal <u>species diversity</u> is sharply reduced in contrast with unsprayed areas. The environmental destruction caused by this defoliation has been described by Swedish Prime Minister <u>Olof Palme</u>, lawyers, historians and other academics as an <u>ecocide</u> (source: see End Notes)

The government of Vietnam says that up to four million people in Vietnam were exposed to the defoliant, and as many as three million people have suffered illness because of Agent Orange. An epidemiological study done by the <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</u> showed that there was an increase in the rate of <u>birth defects</u> of the children of military personnel as a result of Agent Orange.

The Environmental Modification Convention (ENMOD), formally the Convention on the Prohibition of Military or Any Other Hostile Use of Environmental Modification Techniques, is an international treaty prohibiting the military or other hostile use of environmental modification techniques having widespread, long-lasting or severe effects. It opened for signature on 18 May 1977 in Geneva and entered into force on 5 October 1978. The Convention bans weather warfare, which is the use of weather modification techniques for the purposes of inducing damage or destruction.

The <u>United Nations</u> ratified <u>United Nations General Assembly Resolution 31/72</u> and the Environmental Modification Convention.

The hypocrisy of the US war criminals is illustrated by the establishment of the Environmental Protection Agency. Administrator Ruckelshaus was confirmed by the Senate on December 2, 1970, which is the traditional date as the birth of the agency. <u>Five months earlier</u>, in July 1970, President Nixon had signed Reorganization Plan No. 3 calling for the establishment of the EPA.

Malaysians supported the Vietnam War and were complicit in the war crimes committed there, and our country was used as an R & R centre for the US troops to screw our women. One infamous night club was in Jalan Ipoh, Kuala Lumpur! What a price to pay.
