America is worse-off than its so-called allies. Our debt when considered in relationship to productivity as a nation is a sad joke. Other nations might have a worse debt to GDP ratios, but the extent of our debt/service makes for a more terrifying future prospect.

Making the situation worse, a not-so-soft coup has/is being played out in the US. There are calls from university heads to abolish the Constitution as a cause for our ills. Never specific, the calls are generalizations about a need to update *old and in the way*. Calls, sent-out as trial balloons, toes in the water testing, looking for acquiescence.

Two things are taking place at the same time: propagandized compliance—need to gain acceptance from peers is the name of the game. And once mass conformity is achieved, then decisive steps can be taken to strip-away our Bill of Rights protections.

But until sufficient conformity is attained, the coup progresses, 2 steps forward, 1 step back. By increment, power-distribution constitutional mandates shift away from citizens, states, to federal government—a phenomena mostly undiscerned by the many.

Example—war powers. Only Congress can declare war. The last war to be declared was WW2—but US-led wars never end. Under the auspices of administrations, non-declared wars (conducted hand-in-hand with arms manufactures), are now a constant.

These conflicts (often involving loss of life that exceeds declared wars), are done with the legislature handing-over its war-power mandate to various/sundry presidents. Because there is no constitutional mandate—this functions as a constitutional crime.

Congress has become a *rubber-stamp* uni-party, where wealth gatherers shift into corporate jobs—once their 'public service' ends. Consider what goes on in Congress. 50 Intelligence officers dismissed Hunter Biden's laptop as a Russian asset. Intel officers, like Fauci, who lied to Congress, were subject to arrest. Why didn't that happen?

The answer is simple: the coup of our government and consequent conformity among citizens has reached a level at which there is not the will in the legislature/citizens to carry out constitutional mandates. It's gotten so bad that many of us are left hoping that the likes of a nationalist, Trump, can be of some help in saving the republic.

It's said that the game of life is played-out on a *5 inch course*—the space between the ears. Some days, barraged with input I can't possibly assimilate, and overwhelmed, I doubt that America will prevail against the elite mission. To what mission do I refer?

Begin with citizens around the globe summarily charged/sentenced for disseminating

misinformation—contrary to the elite narrative. Did the elite learn from January 6th—that they can throw citizens in prison for years without charges, for taking a Congressional stroll? Are they betting not enough Americans will stand up to them? 2 months before an election, will they do whatever it takes to instill fear into our hearts/minds?
