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Never Attribute to Malice That Which Can Be Explained as Stupidity

The title is known as Hanlon's Razor. Or, don't jump to a conclusion that someone's act is purposefully malicious—when incompetence can explain it. Employing this rationale helps to keep problems from turning hostile, but in the stupid/gullible world we find ourselves, where does the defense of ignorance end and crossing the line into evil begin? Or, are we now so gullible—so as to not be able to get out of the way of our demise?
