Focus On The Dates

The Independence of the United States (the **Declaration of Independence**) was read in Congress on the 4th July 1776.

I quote:

"We, therefore, the Representatives of the united States of America, in General Congress, Assembled, appealing to the Supreme Judge of the world for the rectitude of our intentions, do, in the Name, and by Authority of the good People of these Colonies, solemnly publish and declare, That these United Colonies are, and of Right ought to be Free and Independent States; that they are Absolved from all Allegiance to the British Crown, and that all political connection between them and the State of Great Britain, is and ought to be totally dissolved; and that as Free and Independent States, they have full Power to levy War, conclude Peace, contract Alliances, establish Commerce, and to do all other Acts and Things which Independent States may of right do. And for the support of this Declaration, with a firm reliance on the protection of divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our Fortunes and our sacred Honour."

Why the vehemence?

I quote again:

"... when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new Guards for their future security - Such has been the patient sufferance of these Colonies; and such is now the necessity which constrains them to alter their former Systems of Government. The history of the present King of Great Britain is a history of repeated injuries and usurpations, all having in direct object the establishment of an absolute Tyranny over these States."

Malaya gained Independence in 1957 and I submit that WE DID SO, on similar and valid grounds **but not so eloquently stated as in the Declaration of Independence.**

Our country is comparatively, very young even when we compare our historical trajectory with the United States of America. **We must therefore be humble and not assert that we have some ill-conceived and self-arrogated "superiority".**

In fact and I would suggest that we learn from the President Trump when he asserted with pride that "**we are all immigrants!**" In our National Language,

British colonies in North America some two-and-a-half million subjects of a distant king. Those subjects became a people by declaring themselves such and then by winning the independence they had asserted as their right. They made that assertion on the basis of principle, not blood or kinship or what we today might call 'ethnicity.' Yet this fact must be properly understood."

Read the bloody words highlighted in RED and BOLD! President Trump and the Commissioners referred to France and China.
