They filed a civil claim in court and the Court of Appeal affirmed the decision of the High Court that my client should be awarded RM300, 000.00 for wrongful imprisonment at the Sungai Buloh prison for accompanying me to Europe, to expose the 1MDB fiasco.

That was the “compensation” referred by my dear friend.

I replied, “I did the exposure voluntarily and on my own free will..... No one really bothered That should be the way....”

I trust my recollection serves me right.

I did not file any claims for compensation for wrongful imprisonment!

I recalled vividly my experience and my hunger strike while in prison. The wardens did their duties. I had no complaints and signed a declaration that

should I die from my hunger strike, no one, no official should be responsible for my death while in prison. My signature was accompanied by my thumb print and witnessed by my client, Dato Khairuddin.

I was only a 'player' in a scheme created by **HIM** and I believed fervently that I was tested and by "Faith, Prayer and Fasting" (the mental pain of my hunger strike). I survived.

I am what I am. I learned some hard and painful lessons.

When you are 'nothing' and even though imprisoned, there is but one and one 'friend' only. HIS grace and HIS Gift to guide you - that is all you need!
